Participation in Palm Beach Juniors requires full commitment from both athletes and parents. Volleyball is a team sport that depends on consistent attendance, discipline, and teamwork. Essential skills—such as rotations, footwork, readiness, strategy, transitions, technique, and team communication—are learned and reinforced at practices and tournaments. Missing these opportunities affects both individual development and team performance.

Expectations

- **Commitment & Attendance** Players must attend all practices, tournaments, and team activities. Athletes and parents are expected to support the program's commitment level.
- **Respect & Conduct** Athletes must show respect toward coaches, teammates, opponents, and officials. No player, parent, or coach may make disparaging remarks or gestures toward any individual or team.
- **Academics First** Schoolwork takes priority. Players are expected to manage their time responsibly to balance academics and athletics.
- **Communication** Players must notify coaches **in advance** of any tardiness or absence. Tournament conflicts must be communicated **at least one month in advance**. Leaving a tournament early will be considered quitting the team.
- **Substance Policy** Palm Beach Juniors maintains a **zero-tolerance policy** for alcohol, smoking, and drug use.
- **Facility Responsibility** Players and parents must keep all facilities clean and leave them in good condition.
